### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

***Senior Citizens United Community Services (SCUCS) will be the new provider of paratransit service in Burlington County beginning January 1, 2012.***

SCUCS is a nonprofit corporation located in Haddon Township, Camden County with an office in Delran, Burlington County. The Burlington County paratransit vehicles will operate under the name Sen-Han Transit. At this point, none of the current services you are receiving will be changed but it is hoped that over time additional transportation services will be added or expanded.

***The new toll free number to request/cancel rides is 877-603-5111.***

Begin using this number **Dec. 19, 2011** to schedule rides for appointments you have on or after Jan. 3, 2012. If you need to make or cancel a reservation for an appointment before Dec. 31, 2011, continue to call 800-836-0580.

### ***Nutrition, Employment and Dialysis clients***

Riders receiving nutrition, employment and dialysis transportation will continue to receive rides and do not need to call to schedule these rides. We already have your information and your service will continue as it always has. However, you **MUST** call to cancel a ride.

### ***Medical Appointments***

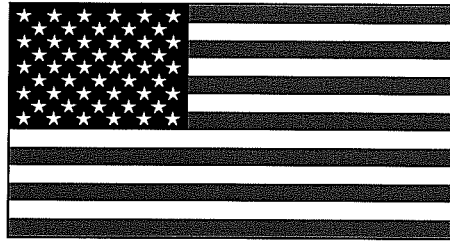
Clients seeking transportation for medical appointments can call two weeks prior to their appointment date. For appointments in 2011, continue to call 800-836-0580. For 2012 appointments, call 877-603-5111.

### ***Veterans***

Veterans Transportation will continue to operate as it has in the past, every Tuesday through Friday from 7 a.m.-5 p.m. Vets will continue to call 609-265-5008 to make a reservation for a ride no later than 11 a.m. the day before their appointment. The **ONLY** change will be the first pickup and last dropoff moving from the Ft. Dix Clinic to American Legion Post #294 in Pemberton.

# **Veterans Bus Stop** **To Change Jan. 3, 2012** **In Ft. Dix/Pemberton**
