TALL SHIPS IN NEWPORT, RI

July 7—Saturday

Board the bus at the former Riviera Ballroom in Audubon for this Tall Ships adventure! On the way to Mystic, CT stop at the Foxwoods Casino to try your luck at one of the country's largest casino complexes. You will receive a bonus package during your five hour stay. Then enjoy a buffet dinner at the casino complex before checking into a Mystic area hotel for a one night stay.

July 8—Sunday

After breakfast, meet your guide to begin a tour of Newport where you will see "The Point" (an historic homestead), the mansions, Ten Mile Drive and Fort Adams and learn about yachting history and the famous summer residents. Then experience the "Days of Sail" during the Trans-Atlantic Regatta as you cruise through the harbor gliding past majestic International Tall Ships as they are moored and docked in beautiful Newport Harbor. Learn all about the ships and crews from your onboard Tall Ships expert and enjoy a delicious hot and cold lunch buffet onboard. After, you can board some of the Tall Ships docked throughout the harbor and the Festival activities. You will stay at a Cape Cod area hotel for the next two nights. Dinner is on your own tonight in Hyannis.

July 9—Monday

Enjoy breakfast before traveling to the Cape Cod coast to hear about the customs, lore and lives of the nautical neighborhoods as you meander through the villages steeped in maritime history. Have lunch in Provincetown (on your own) before boarding a whale watching cruise leaving from Provincetown and see up to five varieties of whales up close and personal with a narration by an onboard naturalist. Learn about the preservation of these gentle giants and their North Atlantic home. Enjoy a lobster dinner with the freshest of New England seafood followed by a fun-filled cabaret-style show.

July 10—Tuesday

After breakfast, visit the Cape Cod Canal Visitor's Center before continuing home.
